## 3. <u>IIS Language policy</u>

- a) The Language Policy was considered and the following points, amongst others, were made:
  - i. A modern language like English is ideally suited as a vehicle for the kind of conceptual discourse and thinking we need in the modern world.
  - ii. We should prioritise national languages of the countries of interest to us over local dialects.
  - iii. The paper should help IIS in the prioritisation of language vis a vis instruction and publication.
  - iv. The paper should include a section on risk management in the quality of translations. Our translations should be of good quality and capture nuances of the primary text.

- v. We may wish to consider a collaborative research project on endangered languages with a university like SOAS.
- vi. An updated version of the policy should be brought back to the Board of Governors for further consideration.

### 4. Launch of the Arkoun archive

a) The Governors were supportive of the proposed reception and academic seminar to mark the launch of the Arkoun archive.
